## **LOAD PLAN REQUIREMENTS**

All Drivers delivering loads into FSD **MUST** have an Export Load Plan.

A Load Plan contains information about the container being delivered.

**ALL INFO IS REQUIRED BEFORE CONTAINER WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

It **MUST** contain the following information:

1. Booking Number.
2. Container Number (4 letters and 7 numbers, unless otherwise marked).
3. Size (Length), Type, and Height of the container.
4. Tare weight of the container.
5. Net weight of the container's cargo.
6. All seal numbers on the container.
7. ANY Hazardous information, or an attached Dangerous Goods Declaration.
8. Reefer Temperature requirements per the Shipper.
9. The delivering Truck Company and tractor number.

We **WILL NOT** correct these Load Plans on behalf of the Drivers.

If the Load Plan is **NOT** correct, the Driver will be directed to change it.
